The DVCR's office has automatically approved the end date of your Macquarie University research scheme funds as follows:

This means that you do not have to put in a ServiceNow request to carry forward the end date beyond 2021 for this grant.

The DVCR's office has advised the following:

- Barring unforeseen circumstances, the expectation is that the funds carried forward into 2022 will be expended in 2022 as no further carry forward will be considered
- This process has only considered internal DVCR funding and if external funds, or internal Department/Faculty funds, need to be carried forward that will need to be done separately
- Researchers do not need to submit a Service Now or any other paperwork for these funds to be carried forward
